

# FY24 FUNDING REQUEST

## Global Gender Community Appropriations Requests

CATEGORY	TOPLINE REQUEST AMOUNT
GENDER EQUALITY (STATE AND FOREIGN OPERATIONS)	No less than <b>\$3,100,000,000</b> in FY24 for global gender equality
GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE	We ask for no less than <b>\$414,000,000</b> to support efforts to prevent and respond to GBV worldwide.
WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT	No less than <b>\$400,000,000</b> for all activities that foster women's economic empowerment and security globally, through the Gender Equity and Equality Action (GEEA) fund.
EMPOWERING ADOLESCENT GIRLS & ADDRESSING CHILD MARRIAGE	No less than <b>\$30,000,000</b> dollars to be dedicated to the implementation of a coordinated and comprehensive effort to end child marriage and meet the needs of married girls globally in alignment with the <u><i>U.S. Global Strategy to Empower Adolescent Girls</i></u> .
WOMEN, PEACE AND SECURITY	No less than <b>\$355,000,000</b> to support the implementation of the Women, Peace, and Security (WPS) Act of 2017, as well as the soon-to-be released updated national WPS strategy and implementation plan and activities of the U.S. Department of State, Department of Defense, Department of Homeland Security, and USAID.
WOMEN'S AND GIRLS' LEADERSHIP	No less than <b>\$50,000,000</b> to increase leadership opportunities for women and girls in countries where they suffer discrimination due to law, policy, or practice.
WOMEN AND GIRLS AT RISK OF VIOLENT EXTREMISM	No less than <b>\$19,000,000</b> to support and engage women and girls who are at risk from extremism and conflict and help with the implementation of the <u><i>U.S. Strategy to Support Women and Girls at Risk from Violent Extremism and Conflict</i></u> released publicly in October 2018.
FAMILY PLANNING	No less than <b>\$1,740,000,000</b> for family planning/reproductive health (\$1.62 billion from the Global Health Programs account and \$116 million from the International Organizations and Programs account) to meet the U.S. fair share of addressing the unmet need for family planning.
